## THIS QUOTATION IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

 The contractor agrees to perform the work in a competent manner in compliance with the specification and description of works on this quotation/estimate. This quotation/estimate does not include premiums incurred for distance from the batch plant, or overage due to insufficient basecourse depths not provided by the same contractor placing the permeable concrete.



- 2. Upon acceptance of this Quotation, "The Client" agrees to a 50% deposit of the quoted amount to secure an appointment. The remaining balance is payable within 7 days upon completion of work. If a project is cancelled by AquaPave due to unforeseen circumstances, the deposit will be refunded in full to the client in a timely manner.
- 3. AquaPave endeavours to provide services that meet and exceed a client's needs and expectations, but in the event of a "change of mind" [after a project has commenced] by "The Client", the initial 50% deposit is forfeited, plus a prorate payment based upon time spent where applicable. "The Client" also agrees to allow AquaPave to showcase any/all work created in the course of a project as part of the AquaPave project portfolio.
- 4. AquaPave shall not be liable for any failure or delay in supply or delivery of products/services where such failure or delay is wholly or partly due to any cause or circumstances whatsoever outside the reasonable control of AquaPave.
- 5. Should additional work not initially quoted be requested during the project, a progress payment will be calculated and payable prior to further work being carried out.
- 6. A newly poured driveway should not be used for seven days. Large, multiple axle trucks should not be allowed to drive onto freshly poured concrete until it has cured for 28 days, as per industry standard.
- 7. Plain or coloured concrete will have colour variations due to chemical reactions during the time of the drying processes.
- 8. All concrete can crack due to variable wind conditions and temperature, regardless of control joint placement. Cracking in concrete is common, and not necessarily a sign of poor workmanship. Damage caused by vehicles is the main contractor's responsibility if the damage occurred during work done as part of the contract. It is not the main contractor's responsibility if the damage was caused by trades or persons that do not fall under their contractual control.

- 10. This quotation may be accepted to form a binding contract upon any one of the following options:
  - a. Email confirmation and payment to AquaPave for the items listed in this quote prior to the expiration date.

- 11. Any payments not made within 30 days of the completion of works shall be subject to a late payment charge of 3% per month (compounded) on the unpaid balance of any amount then passed due. If invoices are not paid with the allotted period all recovery cost will be added to the final invoice.
